We are working hard to create a program for an incredible week - one that is founded in the principles of the labour movement. Campers who have participated at the SFL Summer Camp since 1989 have gone on to do some pretty great stuff and are making a difference.

### We need your help, in a hurry!

We know some of your organizations, locals and labour councils are planning to send in registrations but we have yet to see them. **Please send them in now!**



### **MORNINGS**

Empowering young people through active learning.

You will learn about youth and unions, organizing, knowing your workplace rights, women and equality, challenging and fighting ageism, ableism, transphobia, homophobia, sexism, racism and other issues that affect you as a young person and a young worker. You won't be sitting in a classroom – you will learn by doing!

### **AFTERNOONS**

Afternoons are filled with a variety of recreational activities. Campers will have the opportunity to canoe, go ziplining, play field games, do crafts, try the climbing wall- the list goes on!

#### **EVENINGS**

Campers will have the chance to participate in a variety of activities that include a talent night, initiative tasks, campfire, and much more, with a dance on the last night.

The SFL Summer Camp focuses on issues relevant to young people and addresses challenges facing youth including social justice and equality issues. It combines learning with cooperative recreation activities and lots of guaranteed fun!

Young people between the ages of 13-16 who are children of union members are eligible to attend.

# logistics

#### **DETAILS**

The camp will begin Saturday afternoon, August 19<sup>th</sup>, and end the following Friday morning, August 25<sup>th</sup>.

Staff at our camp include: Youth Activity Coordinators (YACs), Recreation Staff, Counsellors, Food Service Professionals, and Camp Nurses.



Registration is **\$650 per camper** (\$750 for non-SFL affiliates).

Full payment must accompany completed registration in order to qualify.

Some affiliated unions subsidize this cost – check with your union local. Arrangement for payment by the union is the responsibility of the camper's parent(s)/guardian(s).

Limited scholarships are available. Our goal is to ensure no one is excluded because of cost.
